Guadalajara International Film Festival

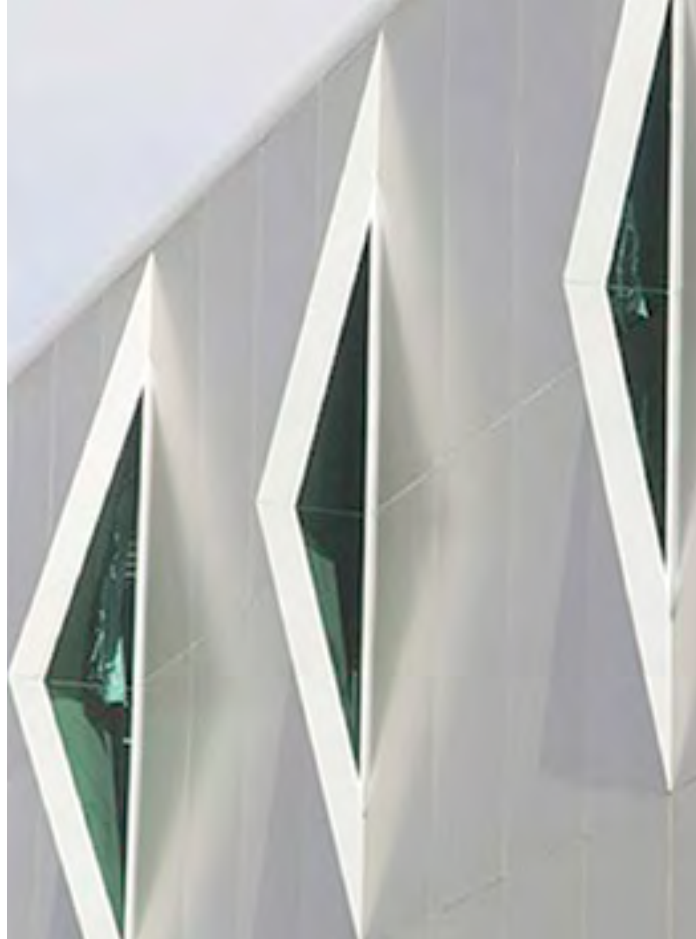
A cultural event and a showcase for the appreciation, promotion and distribution of Mexican and Ibero-American films.
