Academic Excellence – Undergraduate Scholarship

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all undergraduate applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.70 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent). This scholarship is available to students attending the Tampa, Paris, Madrid, and Heidelberg campuses.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, a minimum of 750 words Essay, Original High School or Undergraduate Official Transcripts.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$8,640/€5,544 per semester (up to \$720.00/€462 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.

Schiller International University is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility.

Employer Reimbursement Matching Scholarship – Undergraduate

Eligibility: Students may apply for this scholarship if they are eligible for tuition reimbursement through an employer. This scholarship is available to applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 2.00 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Required CGPA must be maintained for continued eligibility.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, and documentation regarding the employer's tuition reimbursement program or policy.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,000/€3,000 maximum per calendar year. (January 1 – December 31).

Application: The Employer Reimbursement Scholarship is applied to the student's account only upon receipt of the employer contribution.

Employer Reimbursement Matching Scholarship – Graduate

Eligibility: Students may apply for this scholarship if they are eligible for tuition reimbursement through an employer. This scholarship is available to applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.00 or higher on a 4.00 scale. Required CGPA must be maintained for continued eligibility.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, and documentation regarding the employer's tuition reimbursement program or policy.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,000/€3,000 maximum per calendar year. (January 1 – December 31).

Application: The Employer Reimbursement Scholarship is applied to the student's account only upon receipt of the employer contribution..



Alumni Scholarship – Undergraduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Alumni of the University and their dependents enrolling/re-enrolling in an Undergraduate (Associates to Bachelors) degree program. Applicants must have and maintain a CGPA at or above 2.5 (on a scale of 4.0 or equivalent). Students can only apply for the Alumni Scholarship during the initial enrollment process.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay and Proof of Alumni status.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,800/€3,080 per semester (up to \$400.00/€256.67 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.

Schiller International University is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility.

Alumni Scholarship – Graduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Alumni of the University and their dependents enrolling/re-enrolling in a Graduate (Bachelors to Masters) degree program. Applicants must have and maintain a CGPA at or above 3.0 (on a scale of 4.0 or equivalent).

Students can only apply for the Alumni Scholarship during the initial enrollment process.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay and Proof of Alumni status.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$2,300/€1,700 per semester (up to \$191.66/€141.66 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.



Diplomatic Scholarship – Undergraduate

Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all employees of Embassies and Diplomatic Missions around the world and their dependents. Students need to have and maintain a cumulative GPA at or above 2.50 for an Undergraduate program.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Official Transcripts, and Proof of Diplomatic status.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,800/€3,800 per semester (up to \$400.00/€256.67 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.

Schiller International University is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility.

Diplomatic Scholarship – Graduate

Eligibility: his scholarship is available to all employees of Embassies and Diplomatic Missions around the world and their dependents. Students need to have and maintain a cumulative GPA at or above 3.00 for a Graduate program.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Official Transcripts, and Proof of Diplomatic status.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$2,300/€1,700 per semester (up to \$191.67/€ Up to €141.67 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term. If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.



Golden Key Scholarship – Undergraduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Schiller International University students who have been accepted through invitation into the Golden Key Honor Society. This scholarship applies to the top 15% of all University students in all fields based solely on their academic achievements. This scholarship is available to GKHS accepted applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.65 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Golden Key Membership Certificate or Golden Key Letter of Acceptance. You can apply for GKHS membership with the following link: goldenkey.org

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$2,280/€1,800 per semester (up to \$190.00/€150.00 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.

Schiller International University is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility.

Golden Key Scholarship – Graduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Schiller International University students who have been accepted through invitation into the Golden Key Honor Society. This scholarship applies to the top 15% of all University students in all fields based solely on their academic achievements. This scholarship is available to GKHS accepted applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.85 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Golden Key Membership Certificate or Golden Key Letter of Acceptance. You can apply for GKHS membership with the following link: goldenkey.org

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$3,000/€2,400 per semester (up to \$250.00/€200.00 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA. This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.



ICT (Inter-Campus Transfer) Scholarship – Undergraduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Schiller International University undergraduate students who are willing to transfer to another Schiller International University geographic campus location.

Undergraduate students need to have and maintain a CGPA at or above 2.75 for this scholarship.

Terms:

- ICT must be approved by departing campus.
- Scholarship application must be submitted to the receiving.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$1,680/€ 1,320 per semester (up to \$140.00/€110.00 per credit hour). This scholarship is only awarded for a maximum of two semesters per campus location. This scholarship may not be renewed after the second semester per transfer location.

Reapplication: Should the student wish to transfer to another campus location, the student must re-apply for this scholarship each transfer.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for this scholarship, the student will not receive the scholarship for the second semester.

ICT (Inter-Campus Transfer) Scholarship – Graduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Schiller International University graduate students who are willing to transfer to another Schiller International University geographic campus location.

Graduate students need to have and maintain a CGPA at or above 3.25 for this scholarship.

Terms:

- ICT must be approved by departing campus.
- Scholarship application must be submitted to the receiving campus.

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$2,280/€1,680 per semester (up to \$190.00/€140.00 per credit hour). This scholarship is only awarded for a maximum of two semesters per campus location. This scholarship may not be renewed after the second semester per transfer location.

Reapplication: Should the student wish to transfer to another campus location, the student must re-apply for this scholarship each transfer.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for this scholarship, the student will not receive the scholarship for the second semester.



International Scholarship – Undergraduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Undergraduate applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay. High School or College/University transcript Additional supporting documentation may be requested.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Undergraduate: Up to \$3,840/€2,464 per semester (up to \$320/€205.33 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship one it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the students first semester automatically.

After the students' first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the students' CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student will only be able to re-apply for the scholarship, when the required CGPA has been reacquired.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.

Schiller International University is not responsible for notifying a student when they have regained eligibility.

International Scholarship – Graduate

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Graduate applicants who have and maintain a CGPA from their Bachelor Degree of 3.30 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original Undergraduate or High School Official Transcripts. Committee may require additional documentation.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Graduate: \$1,300/€1,040 per semester (Up to \$108.33/€86.66 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term.

If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.



Presidents' Undergraduate Scholarship

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all undergraduate applicants who have and maintain a CGPA of 3.30 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Original High School or Undergraduate Official Transcripts.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,800/€3,080 per semester (up to \$400/€256.67 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Undergraduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term. If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

Presidents' Graduate Scholarship

Initial Eligibility: This scholarship is available to all Graduate applicants who have and maintain a CGPA from their Bachelor Degree of 3.50 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent).

Documentation Required: Scholarship Application, Essay, Undergraduate Official Transcripts.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$2,300/€1,700 per semester (up to \$191.67/€141.67 per credit hour).

Reapplication: Graduate students are not required to re-apply for this scholarship once it has been awarded unless the student fails to maintain the required CGPA.

This scholarship will be awarded at the start of the student's first semester automatically.

After the student's first semester, continued eligibility for the scholarship award will be assessed after the completion of each Semester or Parent Term. If the student's CGPA falls below the minimum CGPA required for the scholarship, the following terms will apply:

- Student will not receive the scholarship for their next semester.
- Student can only re-apply for the scholarship when the required CGPA has been reestablished.
- The granting of a new scholarship is not guaranteed.

If the student needs to reapply after losing eligibility, the student has seven (7) days in which to reapply from when grades are posted.



One World One University Undergraduate Scholarship

Eligibility: Application to this scholarship is available to all Schiller International University undergraduate students who are preparing, personally and professionally, for future leadership roles in an international setting.

Applications for the One World-One University Scholarship will only be considered during the enrollment process for **new** students to Schiller International University starting January 1st, 2022.

Continued eligibility is based on a series of essays or projects to be completed during each academic year to ensure criteria is met.

- 1st Academic Year (Application process): You must demonstrate with a minimum 750-word essay, how you have and how you intend to prepare yourself personally, for a future leadership role in an international setting. What would you like to accomplish relative to one issue starting now, in our current global environment? How will you execute this idea?
- 2nd Academic Year (31- 60 credit hours): You must explain with a minimum 1,000-word essay, and reflecting on your first-year essay, how you will create an action plan to develop your idea professionally.

- 3rd Academic Year (61-90 credit hours): You must demonstrate with a minimum 1,250-word essay, how implementing your action plan will be accomplished. You are required to carry out your action plan during this year.
- 4th Academic Year (91 to 120 credit hours): You must write an essay of a minimum of 1,500 words, evaluating the effectiveness of your action plan and what ideas were successful. What might you change the next time? And now, as a leader in global change, how would you apply what you have learned in your future professional career.

Documentation Required: See criteria above.

Amount of Scholarship Award: Up to \$4,800.00 USD/ €3,080.00 per semester (up to \$400.00/€256.67 per credit hour)

Upon award of the One World-One Universe Scholarship, the Scholarship will be applied to the student ledger card in the following manner:

- This Scholarship will be applied at the end of the student's semesters.
- Students must exhibit and maintain exemplary behavior, sustain academic integrity and be current on any financial obligations (cash payments) to the university.





COVID-19 Pandemic Scholarship for Graduate Applicants

Eligibility: Schiller International University is offering a limited number of Pandemic Scholarships for Graduate Applicants.

The Pandemic Scholarship is available to new applicants wishing to enroll in:

• Our Master's Degree programs starting on or after January 1, 2022.


Documentation Required:

- Scholarship Application form
- Scholarship Essay, minimum 500 words required in English. Applicants must provide a minimum of 500-word essay written in English. The essay must answer the question below in detailed:
 - How has the COVID-19 Pandemic affected your life?
 - What advantages or disadvantages have you experienced?
- Proof of Student Acceptance

Evaluation: The application and essay will be reviewed by the Campus Scholarship Committee utilizing a point granting rubric.

Amount of Scholarship:

- Florida Campus
 - Full 12 Month Graduate program
 - up to \$12,060.00
 - Full 15 Month Graduate program up to \$15,075.00
- Distance Learning Campus
 - Full 12 Month Graduate program up to \$9,540.00
 - Full 15 Month Graduate program up to \$11,925.00
- European Campuses
 - Full 12 Month Graduate program up to €9,540
 - Full 15 Month Graduate program up to €11,925





Early Acceptance Scholarship – Undergraduate and Graduate

Undergraduate and Graduate students applying for admission who successfully complete the enrollment process and reserve a place at Schiller International University.

Eligibility and Amount of Scholarship:

- Complete the enrollment process and satisfy financial obligations 9 months prior to the expected start of your academic career and be awarded up to 10% of the tuition amount. (Students who are awarded an additional Schiller scholarship may be awarded up to 5% of the tuition amount.)
- Complete the enrollment process and satisfy financial obligations 6 months prior to the expected start of your academic career and be awarded up to 6% of the tuition amount. (Students who are awarded an additional Schiller scholarship may be awarded up to 3% of the tuition amount.)

Complete the enrollment process and satisfy financial obligations 3 months prior to the expected start of your academic career and be awarded up to 4% of the tuition amount. (Students who are awarded an additional Schiller scholarship may be awarded up to 2% of the tuition amount.)

Process:

- Application Form not required.
- Eligibility to be confirmed by Admissions Office.
 One-time award for the student's first Academic Semester (4 courses).
- Notification of approved scholarship sent by Admissions to Bursars Office.

Schiller Premier Scholarship - Undergraduate and Graduate

Undergraduate and Graduate students accepted for admission who are prepared by successfully completing the enrollment process and financial obligations prior to starting coursework.

Eligibility and Amount of Scholarship:

- Students who have been accepted, completed the enrollment process, and satisfied all financial obligations for a full academic year (10 courses) prior to starting coursework are eligible to be awarded a scholarship amount of up to 5% of tuition.
- Students who have been accepted, completed the enrollment process, and satisfied all financial obligations

for the full Bachelor or Master program prior to starting coursework are eligible to be awarded a scholarship amount of up to 10% of tuition.

Eligible to be combined with any other University Scholarships.

Process:

- Application Form not required.
- Eligibility to be confirmed by Admissions Office.
 One-time award does not require renewal.
- Notification of approved scholarship sent by Admissions to Bursars Office.



Schiller Student and Alumni Referral Scholarship – Undergraduate and Graduate

This scholarship is for new students enrolling in a full-time Undergraduate or Graduate degree program who have been referred by a current student or of alumni from the university. Students graduating from Schiller and choose to pursue an additional degree with Schiller are also eligible to apply.

Initial Eligibility:

- Newly enrolling students into an Undergraduate or Graduate degree program.
- Alumni and student referrals must be submitted prior to the student's application.
- Student must maintain a good academic and financial standing with the University.

Award Amounts:

- Schiller student pursuing an additional degree may be eligible for a scholarship award amount of up to 25% of tuition of new program.
- Alumni pursuing an additional degree may be eligible for a scholarship award of up to 25% of tuition of new program.
- Referral of an immediate family member (parent, spouse, sibling, or child) of a current student or alumni may be eligible for a scholarship award of up to 20% of tuition.
- Referral of a relative of a current student or alumni may be eligible for a scholarship award of up to 15% of tuition.
- Referral of a friend of a current student or alumni may be eligible for a scholarship award of up to 10% of tuition.

Process:

- Referral Form submitted to Admissions Office.
- Eligibility to be confirmed by Admissions Office to include active student/alumni status.
- Notification of approved scholarship sent by Admissions to Bursars Office.

Partners, Suppliers, and Associations Scholarship – Undergraduate and Graduate

This scholarship is for new students enrolling in a full-time Undergraduate or Graduate degree program who have been referred by one of Schiller International University Partner's, Suppliers, or Associations.

Initial Eligibility: Partner, Institution, or Association have an active agreement with Schiller International University.

- New students referred by Partners and Suppliers may be eligible for a scholarship award amount of up to 15% of tuition.
- New students referred by Associations may be eligible for a scholarship award amount of up to 10% of tuition.

Process:

- Referral Form submitted to Admissions Office.
- Proof of Partner, Supplier, or Association relationship to be submitted with Referral Form (business card, proof of employment, signed letter of recommendation from employee on letterhead).
- Eligibility to be confirmed by Admissions Office.
